



### Other ACA WSO Services

- 1) Operate website
- 2) Maintain meeting list
- 3) Provide fellowship assistance on request
- 4) Convene an Annual Business Conference (and now three additional Quarterly Delegate Meetings)
- 5) Hold an ACA World Convention with recovery workshops

#### What Is the Annual Business Conference?

- 1) All members of ACA shall be invited to attend the ABC, with each affiliated Meeting and Intergroup designating one voting delegate and an alternate.
- 2) The group conscience obtained from the delegates in attendance shall provide direction, recommendations, and/or Special Committees to the Board for conducting the business of ACA WSO.
- 3) Convene an annual conference where consideration regarding the business of ACA WSO occurs and priorities for the coming year are discussed and implemented when/where feasible.
- 4) Ratify board trustees.

#### What Is the Annual Business Conference?

Concept 2: "The actual voice, the effective conscience for our whole fellowship."

Concept 6: "Traditionally has the final decision respecting large matters of general policy and finance."


#### ACA Concepts of Service

#### What Is the Annual Business Conference?

Tradition 4: "Each group is autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or ACA as a whole."

ABC Focus is on WSO priorities and adherence to program principles, not on issuing directives to individual meetings, intergroups, etc.

# How Does the ABC Work?





### How Does the ABC Work?

- 1) Reports on WSO and Conference business
- 2) Debate and vote on motions and proposals
- 3) Give input and make decisions about major policy and finance issues
- 4) Ratify board trustees



### How Does the ABC Work?

- 1) Voting and discussion rules set out in policy manual (OPPM)
- 2) Emphasis on making sure all voices are heard (eg, time limits)
- 3) Group conscience discussion, with limited use of Robert's Rules of Order
- 4) Electronic voting
- 5) Virtual meetings on Zoom
- 6) Worldwide Online Voting



# ABC: Volunteer Support Roles, Part 1

- 1) Conference Co-Chairs
- 2) Conference Secretary
- 3) Conference Parliamentarian

These are high-level service positions and require some experience.



# ABC: Volunteer Support Roles, Part 2

- 1) Speaker Time
- 2) Session Timer
- 3) Web and Tech support
- 4) Point of Order Intake
- 5) Point of Information Intake
- 6) Speaker Timer
- 7) Session Timer



# ABC Volunteer Roles, FAQ

- 1) Why SHOULD I volunteer? Shouldn't personal recovery take priority?
- 2) How much experience do I need?
- 3) What do I have to do to prepare?
- 4) Will this affect my ability to serve as a delegate?
- 5) Do I have to be a volunteer for the whole two days?
- 6) Other



### How Else Can You Serve?

- 1) ABC/QDM Committee
- 2) ABC/QDM Study Committees
- 3) Communicate to your home group
- 4) Stay active in Slack channel
- 5) Explore other WSO committees and working groups (eg, literature/publishing; fellowship engagement; business operations; policy)
- 6) Delegate engagement & training
