• Q: Finance committee, are you looking for members and are members from the Fellowship welcome?

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- A: Yes, fellowship members are welcome. Please contact Tamara or Bill. Also the audit committee could use support.

- Q: Can someone explain the discrepancy between the number of delegates at the QDM quoted by Sue V and the number of delegates at Quorum.
- A: Delegates can register, but not everyone shows up.
- Q: The General Manager said there was a \$29,000 reduction in expenses and that there was no reduction of services, so why was that \$29,000 in the budget?
   To begin with, associated services with it?
- A: We planned to hire a supervisor for the warehouse, and we have one employee. Our shipments have increased by 20% this past year over what they used to be, and it is just one guy handling them. We were going to hire a supervisor if the revenue supported it, and unfortunately, the revenue did not. The 7th tradition was down a little bit compared to what we forecasted.
- Q: For delegates to be informed, it would be helpful to have all reports in advance in one place so people could come informed.
- A: We are operating at breakneck speed, and it was very important to bring the budget analysis to the August QDM. We aim to do everything in advance as we can, but sometimes, it just can't happen. Hopefully, we will improve in the future with more resources, and we want to make it easy for the delegates to find information. We are looking to centralize everything in one place.
- Q: Do we actually employ people on the payroll, do we keep people on a salary basis? And how is the board different from trustees?
- A: The board is all of the trustees and the trustees are individual ACA members that serve on the board. No board members are employees or take a salary.
- Q: In order to serve on the finance committee, does one have to be a delegate or just a member of the fellowship?
- A: You don't have to be a delegate, you can be a member of this fellowship at the meeting level and you don't need to have any finance experience.

#### Social media


- I thought we were a program of attraction rather than promotion and does this social media presence go against this?
- Which social media in particular will be used and what guidelines will be enforced to make sure whatever we post stays within the guidelines of the program?
- What is the minority opinion? Who is the minority here?

#### **Answers**

 If people can't see us, they can't find us, so we use social media as a tool to make ourselves public and increase our visibility. We have looked at other 12 step programs and they're all using social media. So it's not about promotion, it's about attraction and visibility.

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- Regarding policies of using it, we set up strict guidelines in the pilot, about how we would monitor it and not allow some posts on some items and some platforms, but just allow likes and followers. To date there have been no negative comments that the moderator has had to respond to.
- We have a consultant who is doing some of the work here for us getting our page built and doing the moderation. We had a budget approved in 2023 to do that and put it in again for 2024 to have someone to manage the social media platforms.

# **Large Group Discussion about Breakout Room Topics Discussion:**

- Regarding how do delegates want to develop topics for ABCs/QDMs that are submitted. The ones that get presented are those with the most votes, however marginalized committees represent a very small percentage so they will never be considered statistically significant and not be chosen topics. I would like to see factors such as inclusion and representation be valid reasons for presenting a certain topic.
- When presenting reports like financial reports, talk to me like I'm a 5 year old keep it simple. Concerns about the voting process going against our spiritual unity
   call out to delegates as we only have 2% at this moment to show the description
  of the service, the training, the observer opportunities to motivate people to be the
  delegate for their own group. And lastly, having motions at least one month ahead
  so I can represent my group's voice instead of my own.
- As we log into the delegate meeting, there is a welcome in the chat with a checklist so we aren't scrambling and can get organized for the meeting and have all the info available for the meeting
- Something that stuck out for me is that we don't use an international meeting
  format so people who aren't in the US are struggling with the format and how we
  conduct our business and we need to provide more support for the international
  community.
- We talked a lot about the survey and how few people fill it out at the end of the QDM. Maybe let new delegates know that they will be participating in a survey at the end of this meeting to bring about new topics forward so I would have time to go to my group. Also, maybe an email to new delegates directly about what will be happening and what the expectations are.
- I'd like to see more spiritual direction discussion as opposed to a very

business-oriented about the cost of taking the decisions that one does for recovery and the money will come if there is a good call collectively for us. For Recovery topics to come organically and a separate business section where we talk about monetary implications.

- Rather than links, sending out emails with full documentation prior to the conference, so everyone would have all the relevant information in front of them.
- I did appreciate the breakout room as it gave me the opportunity to reveal some of
  the fears about being on this meeting for the first time. Part of the process needs
  to be breaking down the social barriers within the meeting itself. When I see only
  certain people speaking to each other and not addressing the actual meeting, that
  causes a bit of confusion and separation for me. Something to keep in mind for
  the officers as you are speaking.
- Question: Did people find the breakout rooms to be valuable?
  - 50 delegates raised hands
- The ability to organize the delegates separate from WSO and not wait for WSO to do it as with this meeting. To be able to fund and receive funds independently such as in other organizations. Intergroups receive their own funds and organize independently and each group contributes not just to the main organization but to the intergroup so the delegates can vote for people and so not look at WSO paternally. I would like to hear what delegates think of this idea.
- Vote for full amount of time for this section which will extend the conference 15 minutes: 33 in favour, 20 opposed.
- Minority for opposition:
  - I appreciate efforts being made to keep things on track and I have another service commitment and unable to go over time
  - I am in Australia and its already 3am
  - I would like to respect the time and the agenda and have the extra 15 minutes after the session
- Revote to extend conference 15 minutes: 11 in favour, Rest not in favour.

- I heard a lot about prioritizing advanced sharing of documents and simplifying topics. How many people generally think that is an idea that should be prioritized in conference planning: 38 in favour, none opposed.
- How many people generally agree with newcomer experience need for support be prioritized: 34 in favour.
- Informal ways for delegates to gather is this something that should be prioritized? 39 in favour.


