Facts about our ACA Board of Trustees.

- ACA is registered as a non-profit corporation and has a specific legal status.
- A minimum of 3 Trustees is required to exist as a non-profit.
- May have up to 20 Trustees.
- A fiduciary duty is the highest standard of care in law.
 - Meeting the legal requirements of a Non-profit
 - Conducting ACA's business
 - Protecting ACA's assets
- -Unpaid volunteers.

-Trustees must be ratified yearly.

-Trustees serve 2 year terms - up to 3 terms.

-Our Trustees volunteer from 8 - 20+ hours per week.

- Decisions are made using a group conscience & the principles of our ACA Steps, Traditions, and Concepts of Service.

NomCom vets and nominates qualified Board candidates to the Board of Trustees.

How?

- Search for Board candidates
- Advertise monthly for Board & NomCom openings.
 - ***Need to add 2-5 Trustees yearly to replace Trustees that rotate off of service.
- We receive applications.
 - ***All members must apply to be considered.
- Interview candidates and their references
- Nominate qualified candidates to the Board.

Part I. Qualifications & Time Commitment

The following are the desired qualifications that Board candidates should meet before being considered for the position of Trustee (OPPM, Section II, L). This applies to both <u>At Large</u> and <u>Regional candidates</u>:

Abbreviated Trustee Qualifications:

- 1. At least 5 yrs of attendance at ACA meetings.
- 2. One or more years of active service on a WSO Committee
- 3. Attendance on at least 2 of the 4 yearly WSO Board Meetings with the Fellowship.
- 4. Working knowledge of ACA's Steps, Traditions, Concepts of Service & grounded in the group conscience process.

- 5. May not hold a similar position in another 12-step fellowship.
- 6. Demonstrated skill working in a group and completing projects.
- 7. Ability to donate substantial time
- 8. Willingness to abide by and sign:
 - the WSO Commitment to Service
 - WSO Conflict of Interest Policy
 - Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).
- 9. Agree to protect confidential information during Trustee service and after leaving the Board.

10. Demonstrated emotional sobriety and effectiveness during conflict & honoring minority opinions.

11. Strong organizational and communication skills.

We <u>can</u> make exceptions for some of these.

*****But, there is <u>never</u> an exception for a lack of emotional sobriety or being grounded in the ACA steps, Traditions, or Concepts.

NomCom members have the same qualifications.

Our vetting process is almost identical to the Board's.
