Strong participation reflects commitment to unity, service, and informed group conscience - regardless of the outcome of any vote.

Guided by Concept I: final responsibility and ultimate authority reside in the collective conscience of the whole fellowship.

What is Fellowship Group Voting?

A Conference-approved process that gives every registered ACA group the opportunity to learn, discuss, and vote directly on fellowship-wide matters.



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Who Supports the Process?

Different roles work together so groups can receive accurate information and vote with confidence.

FGV Advisory Team

Coordinates the FGV webpage, Town Halls, monthly communications, resources, and process support.

IT Support

Maintains the voting system, unique links/codes, group contacts, registration updates, and technical assistance.

Data Analysis

Supports vote integrity, participation tracking, results reporting, and clear presentation of outcomes.

The Concepts Committee presents and answers questions about the Concept II proposal.

How Groups Vote

Voting is for registered ACA groups — meetings, intergroups, and regions.

Unique Link

Emailed to registered group contacts at the beginning of each month.

2

One Group, One Vote

The group holds a group conscience and submits Yes, No, or Abstain.

3

Vote Can Change

Groups may update/change their vote until voting closes on December 3.

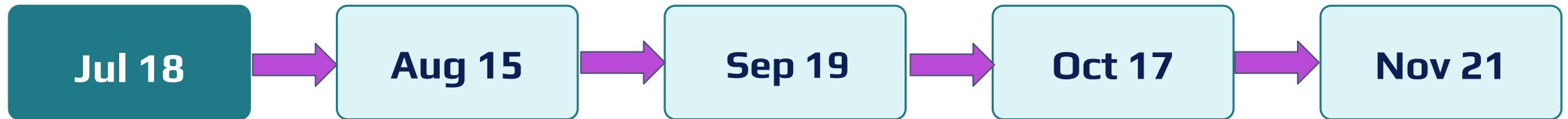
Voting Timeline & Town Halls
